

WORCESTER MEMORIAL AUDITORIUM

The Worcester Memorial Auditorium is recognized as a fine facility . . . both in architectural beauty and in its flexibility. Here you find a structure so flexible in its arrangements, and facilities that practically any type of gathering can be handled with a maximum of efficiency.

Facing Lincoln Square, the Auditorium is in the heart of activity, with easy access from all incoming highways.

FOYER

The main foyer has an area of 3,016 square feet. It is ideal for registration headquarters or exhibits.

MAIN AUDITORIUM

Seating capacity of 3000. Seats are removable to yield 18,212 square feet of floor space for dancing or exhibits.

Additional exhibit space is available on the lower level of the auditorium.

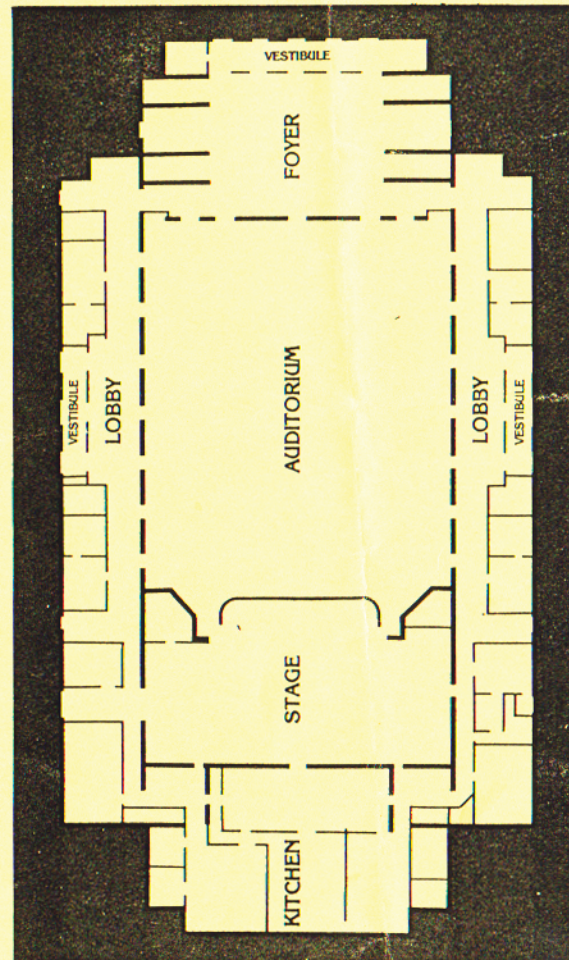

STAGE

44 feet deep, 116 feet wide overall. Proscenium arch 68½ feet wide, 44 feet high. Lighting system and curtains for any scale production. Orchestra lift with console organ may be raised or lowered from basement to stage levels. Special seating equipment seats chorus of 630 on stage. Stage ramp permits large trucks to be driven directly onto stage. Contains 57-67 sets of lines. The stage is designed to serve both the Main Auditorium and the Little Theatre in the rear. Sound-proof curtains permit performances to be held in each hall simultaneously.

With the use of stage seating, in conjunction with the theatre and auditorium, it is possible to seat nearly 5000 people for convention purposes.



DRESSING ROOMS

The "Green Room" off-stage is a beautiful suite for guest stars with private entrance from the street. Adjacent is the musician's room. Assembly room and dressing rooms are located directly behind stage. Off the assembly room are the kitchen and two chorus rooms.

ORGAN

The Kimball console organ in the Main Auditorium is one of the finest in the east. The design and specifications were the result of two years of study by experts in an attempt to secure the ideal stops and combinations which would best fill the requirements of a genuine concert instrument to meet the varied demands of the Auditorium. Its specifications include 6,719 pipes, 186 knobs and tablets and 58 adjustable combinations.

LITTLE THEATRE

The Little Theatre is located at the western end of the building. With seating on the floor and in the balcony for 704.

A perfect view of the stage is presented from every seat in the unusually intimate and attractive theatre.

Fully equipped with a built-in projection booth, the Little Theatre may be used alone or may be opened to join the Main Auditorium for overflow crowds.
